



## St Christopher's Church

As we remember.

The phrase "Lest we forget" is commonly used in war and remembrance services commemorative occasions in English speaking countries, in particular on 11th November Remembrance Day and sung as a hymn in New Zealand and Australia on 25th April ANZAC Day remembering members of the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps who fought at Gallipoli against the Ottoman Empire during World War One. Before the term was used in reference to soldiers. and war, it was first used in an 1897 Christian poem written by Rudvard Kipling called "Recessional". The phrase occurs 8 times; and is repeated at the end of the first 4 stanzas in order to add particular emphasis regarding the dangers of failing to remember.

> 'God of our fathers, known of old, Lord of our far-flung battle line, Beneath whose awful hand we hold Dominion over palm and pine— Lord God of Hosts, be with us yet, Lest we forget—lest we forget!'

The concept of 'being careful not to forget' was already present in the Bible Deuteronomy 4:7-9): 7"For what nation is there so great, who hath God so nigh unto them, as the Lord our God is in all things that we call upon him for? 8And what nation is there so great, that hath statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day?9Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, lest thou forget the things which thine eyes have seen, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life: but teach them thy sons, and thy son's sons ....'

Further on we have In Deuteronomy 6:12, "Then beware lest thou forget the Lord which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt". This Biblical quote could probably be a direct source for the term in the 1897 poem. The main theme of the "Recessional" poem is that if a nation forgets the true source of its success (the "Lord God of Hosts" and His "ancient sacrifice" of "a humble and contrite heart") - its military or material possessions will be insufficient in times of war. It became a plea not to forget past sacrifices, and was often found as the only wording on War Memorials or used as an epitaph.

Earlier this year I had the immense privilege to travel as a member of the Newmarket Community Choir to Ypres in Belgium where we sang at the Menin Gate during the wreath laying ceremony where hundreds of thousands of Commonwealth soldiers are honoured and in those truly emotive moments I also felt a true sense of calm, peace and humility as I recalled how Jesus Christ paid the ultimate sacrifice

for each and every one of us as he was us nailed to a cross for our sins, during a part of one of the church services we eat a symbolic piece of blessed bread which Jesus ate at his last meal, and we use the words 'Do this in remembrance of me,' and we remember that our Lord offered his life for us, to bear our sin and open up the gateway as promised to give us eternal life if we but only choose to live our lives out according to the way of Jesus and Gods

I will leave you with the words of Major Malcolm Boyd, killed in action in France, June 1944

"If I have to say goodbye to stream and wood, To wide ocean and the green clad hill, I know that he, who made this world so good, Has somewhere made a heaven better still. This bears witness with my latest breath, Knowing the love of God, I fear no death."

Jesus loves Red Lodge! Trevor.

"But thank God. He gives us the victory over sin and death through our Lord Jesus Christ. "1 Corinthians 15:57 (NLT)


